# Players

- ◆ Be positive – always try to make the game better for yourself and your team
- ◆ **Play by the Laws and rules of the game**
- ◆ Respect all the referee's decisions without argument. Remember, "The referee is always right – particularly when he/she is wrong"
- ◆ **Control your temper – shouting at team-mates, opponents, or referees is not acceptable**
- ◆ Be a good sport – Recognise good play by all players on your team and by your opponents
- ◆ **Be the best that you can be, try your hardest and never give up – the aim of playing is to have fun, improve your skills and do your best**
- ◆ Play because you want to, not just to please your coaches or parents
- ◆ **Recognise and appreciate the efforts made by coaches, parents and referees in providing the chance for you to play rugby**
- ◆ At the end of play, always thank your opponents and the referee for their involvement
