



Parents/Spectators

- ◆ Do not force an unwilling youngster to participate
- ◆ Never ridicule or shout at children for making a mistake or losing
- ◆ Encourage all children to play by the Laws and rules of the game
- ◆ Remember that young people learn by example – set a good example for them to follow
- ◆ Respect the role and decisions of match officials, before, during and after the game.
- ◆ Recognise the value and importance of volunteer coaches and officials. They give their time and resources freely to provide recreational activities for your children
- ◆ Turn defeat into victory by helping young people to develop a positive ethic for self and team improvement
- ◆ Teach young people that playing sport within the rules and to the best of your ability is more important than winning or losing
- ◆ Recognise, encourage and applaud good play and sportsmanship from all players, both in your child's team **and** their opponents'
- ◆ Be aware of the Club Child Protection Policy which will be displayed on the club notice board and on the website (www.penicuikrugby.org)
