Please enjoy your day at Cavalry Park and I wish you and your club well for the future.



### GAME GUIDE


All ties will be 7 minutes each way with a 1-minute interval. All other rules as per the Laws of Rugby which can be found online.

Please be at your allocated pitch 5 minutes prior to the Tie start time.


## PITCH LAYOUT & FACILITIES

#### Games will be played across the 3 numbered pitches.


- Please register your team upon arrival.

## GAME SCHEDULE CAPTAINS SHIELD


